THE TOWNSHIP OF METAMORA ORDAINS:

Section 1. CODE ADOPTED. The Uniform Traffic Code for Michigan Cities, Villages and Townships promulgated by the Director of State Police and published in the 1979 edition of the Michigan Administrative Code and amendments as published in the quarterly supplement number 5 to the 1979 edition of the Michigan Administrative Code, in accordance with Public Act 62 of 1956, is hereby adopted by reference.

Section 2. REFERENCES IN CODE. References in the Uniform Traffic Code for Michigan Cities, Townships and Villages to "governmental" unit" shall mean the Township of Metamora.
