

Permanent Absentee Voter List Request Form

Metamora Township's Clerk office maintains a Permanent Absent Voter List. The Permanent Absent Voter List is a list of voters who qualify under state law to vote by absentee ballot. All voters that are on the Permanent Absent Voter list are sent an *Absentee Ballot Application* for each election that is scheduled in Metamora Township.

In order to qualify to be on the Permanent Absentee Voter list, you must be a registered voter at least 30 days prior to an election, apply in writing to be included on the List, and meet one of the following criteria:

- 1. Age 60 years or older
- 2. Unable to vote without assistance at the polls
- 3. Expecting to be out of town on Election Day
- 4. In jail awaiting arraignment or trial
- 5. Unable to attend the polls due to religious reasons
- 6. Appointed to work as an election inspector in a precinct outside of your precinct of residence
