When sending in a tax payment for the winter 2016 tax season, please include the bottom portion of your tax bill. Please make check/money orders out to **Metamora Township**. Also, please include your property number on your check/money order.

Taxes are payable **December 1st, 2016** thru **February 14th, 2017**. After February 14th, an additional 3% penalty will be added until February 28th, 2017 on any **unpaid** balance.

March 1st, 2017 all delinquent taxes are sent to the Lapeer County Treasurer @ 255 Clay Street, Suite 303 Lapeer, MI 48446.

Taxpayers that have a mortgage escrow will have a bill sent to them to keep for their records and a bill will be sent to your mortgage company.
