New Business

A. Application for Planned Unit Development Classification for Transitory Extraction of Natural Resources/Part II-Need for Natural Resources/American Aggregates of Michigan and Great Lake Counsel, Inc., Boy Scouts of America ("the Applicants").

Attorney Fisher explained that this application is submitted under Part II of the Zoning Ordinance but it really is Phase I, or administrative review, and stated further that the Planning Commission will be relying on the review of experts for this application. Attorney Fisher recommended that the Board receive the application at this meeting and refer it to Township Supervisor Best and Township Attorney Nolan. Brief discussion.

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Board to set an administrative hearing for next month's meeting reiterating that this step is the determination on the need for sand and gravel in Southeastern Michigan.

Attorney Fisher pointed out that it is unlikely that it would be feasible to have the hearing next month because the material needs to be reviewed thoroughly and stated that he will keep Attorney Hindelang informed as to what is being done and that it is not being delayed.

Unfinished Business

A. Language of Special Land Use Permit for Drop and Lock on outdoor storage & rental activities.

Planner Piggott distributed to the Board a draft Special Land Use Permit for Drop and Lock Self Storage and reviewed same. The easement agreement for water runoff was discussed and Mr. Bellinger stated it was signed and he would provide a copy to the Township.
